Due to the low turn out on Monday mornings there is no Monday morning service.

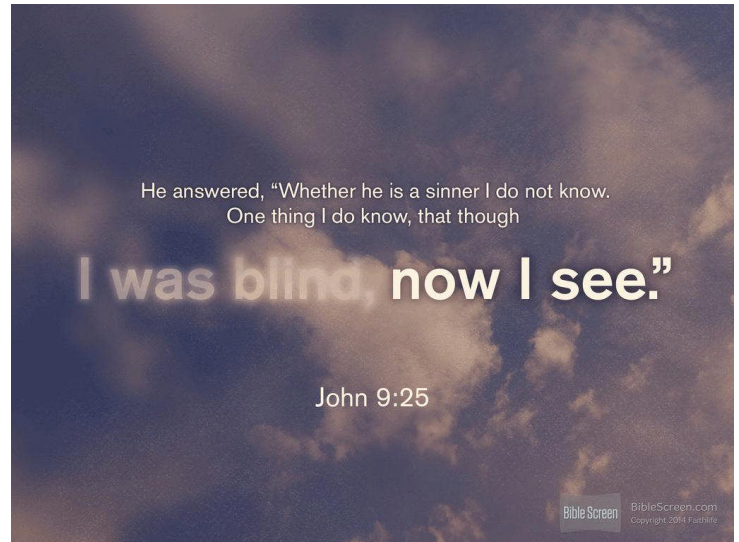
On Tuesday morning there will be Mass at 7.15am & 10.00am

## Funeral Mass

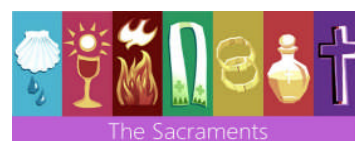
Please note the time of Mass on Thursday is 1.00pm for the Funeral Mass of Margaret Barclay. There will be no 10.00am Mass.
