## Church Refurbishment

We have given the go ahead to some final works on the Church for the moment. Last week some new lighting was added to the canopy at the front of the Church, the statue of Our Lady at the Grotto and to the Sacristy. Work has begun to add a small glass balustrade to the top of the wall at the front of the balcony to improve safety. The cost is around £4000 and should be completed in a few weeks once the glass has arrived. We have started redecorating the sacristy area for the first time in about 25 years and badly needed new flooring is ordered and should be fitted in the next couple of weeks costing around £2500.

The major cost that lies ahead in the coming years will be the need to replace the main Church roof. While some work was done last year to prolong the life of the roofing on the flat areas, the Parish Finance Team decided it was wise to start saving towards this cost. This week and approximately monthly after the summer we will start 2nd collections for the Church Roof.
