Parish Lourdes Pilgrimage

Would you like to join a 4 night pilgrimage to Lourdes in June 2018 staying in the 4* Hotel Padoue near the grotto. Alba Tours have provided prices for a 4 night stay between 9—16 June 2018. Exact dates to be confirmed when flights become available in the next month or so.

Flights from Edinburgh to Bordeaux are with Ryanair then a 3 hour transfer to Lourdes by Coach. Flights should cost around £200 to £240. The Hotel on a full board basis and Coach Transfers would cost £349. A total of around £600pp. Single Room supplement is £90.

If you are interested please add your name to the list on the notice board. The pilgrimage needs at least 30 people signed up by end of May to be viable. A deposit of Flight cost plus £50 would be required to book when flights are available.

Sacrament of Reconciliation & Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

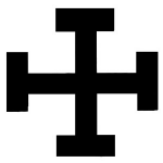
