
CARFIN LOURDES GROTTO

NOVENA IN HONOUR OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Church has long had the practice of invoking the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit between the Solemnity of the Ascension (Thursday of this week) and the Solemnity of Pentecost (two weeks today).

We will pray the Novena to the Holy Spirit during Mass from Friday of this week up to and including the Saturday before Pentecost Sunday.

Thursday of this week is a holyday of obligation for the Ascension of the Lord.
