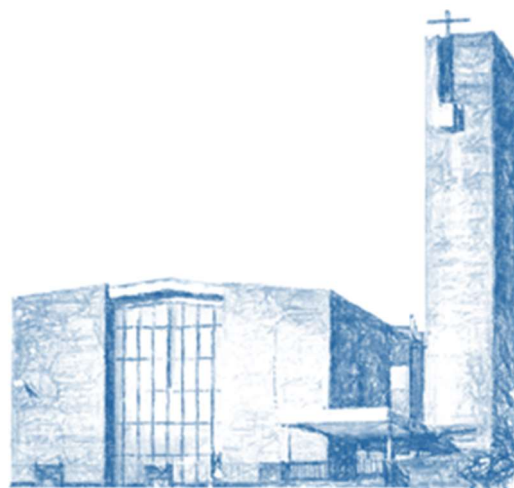

Reflection on the Readings

Our liturgy is a real roller-coaster today. We begin by waving branches and shouting "Hosanna!" It is not long before we shout "Crucify Him!" to the very one we were lauding as king. The people of Jerusalem were a fearful and fickle bunch, and the apostles not much better; as we enter the great drama of Holy Week, how are we going to react to the swell of emotion that Holy Week brings?

If anyone's existing EHIC is out of date, or anyone does not possess a health insurance card, then they should apply for one via the website above. They can also obtain a form from the Post Office. However, the quickest way is to apply online. Both online and PO applications are free of charge.

Some people have, but most don't have, travel insurance. Those who wish to use their own existing travel insurance must put the insurance company, AND the policy number on the Booking Form. Anyone who does not have travel insurance, are advised to take out Tangney Tours travel insurance at an additional cost of £41.00 on top of their flights and accommodation. costs.
