

FOODBANK

Thank you so much for your outstanding generosity this month with 18 bags and £1778. The level and sustained nature of your kindness is both humbling and remarkable. At the request of our Parish's SSVP we were asked if we could allocate some of your generosity towards Loaves & Fishes, a Foodbank that also operates within our community. Because of a lack of resources, Loaves and Fishes launched a recent appeal for help on Facebook. In response to that appeal and in discussion with Fr Frank we have shared over £500 from the above sum to them. Additionally, Fr Frank has assigned an extraordinary sum of £455 for the same cause, meaning £2233 has been allocated across the two Foodbanks this month. It would be difficult to describe the appreciation and emotion from Loaves & Fishes when this happened - 'overwhelming' might just do it. With your indulgence, it would be our intention in the future to donate food bags and a sum of money to the Community Foodbank and a sum of money to Loaves and Fishes each month.
