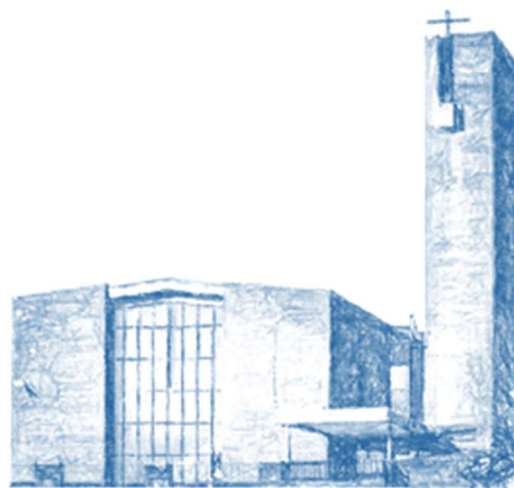

## REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

The Holy Trinity is famously difficult to understand. The problem is not that the Trinity is complicated: rather, it's the simplicity of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, which is so hard to grasp. In the liturgy we celebrate the closeness to us of God whom we know and address as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The closeness of the Trinity is seen in the number of times Father, Son and Holy Spirit are invoked in the liturgy.
