

REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

This passage reminds us what will be the outcome of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem – his death. The thought of it prompts Jesus to describe what lies ahead as a baptism with which he has still to be baptised. Not another immersion in water, surely? We might note that baptism literally means immersion. Jesus is immersed in his mission - his death.

No wonder he is preoccupied. 'Distressed' does not express this well - he is obsessed, rather than distressed.
