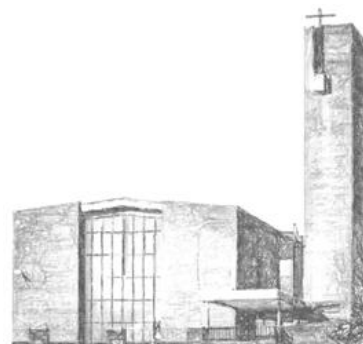

REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

Only on the last Sunday of Advent do we ever have an infancy narrative story in the gospel; this year, Matthew's 'annunciation' to Joseph, rather than to Mary. In his acceptance of Mary's child, Joseph sets in motion the final part of the history of the line of David. By adoption, Mary's child, whom she will call 'Jesus', will be descended from King David. There will be no further descendants after Jesus: he will be the eternal king!
